### **Immediate Opportunities:**

- Volunteer Committee

### **Work Construction Session Opportunities:**

- Building Supplies (acquire new and used building material donations)
- Site Leader (lead adults and teens on one work site)
- Preview Homes (assess needs, determine materials needed, and report to Session Coordinator)
- Work Session Volunteer (Teen)
- Work Session Volunteer (Adult women and men)

### **Monthly or Quarterly Opportunities:**

- Meal Crew (secure food donations, arrange for pickup and delivery)
- Publicity (coordinate newsworthy information for local media and local groups)
- Envelope Stuffers (quarterly newsletter, site leader folders, promos, etc.)
- Donation pick-ups (pickup donations from local store and private individuals, drop off at warehouse)
- Warehouse Organization (a team that maintains order and an inventory of the tools, equip. & materials)
- Website Support (help maintain current events)

### **Once or Twice a Year Event Opportunities:**

- Okra Strut (design, construct and/or ride on parade float - Sept/Oct)
- Peru Mission (design, distribute collection boxes, pickup donations from churches, sort - June/July)
- Tour of Columbia (serve on a committee to invite people, organize the trolley route, media - Jan-Mar)
- Information Booths (answer questions an event table for schools and community festivals)
- Silent Auction (serve on a committee that secures and pickup donations and organizes silent auction)
